Backgrounder

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Open source gives teams freedom. Running it well in production is hard work. Elestio removes that operational burden so companies can adopt open source software without hiring a platform team to babysit it.

The problem

Modern software teams are caught between two bad options. Proprietary SaaS is easy to start with but locks data and workflows inside someone else's platform, with per seat pricing that climbs every year. Self hosting open source restores control, but it means owning installation, security patching, backups, monitoring and updates, for every tool, forever.

What Elestio does

Elestio is a managed open source platform. Teams deploy more than 400 open source software packages in one click, on the cloud provider and region of their choice, and Elestio keeps them running: hardened by default, backed up automatically, monitored and updated. Customers can bring their own cloud account or use Elestio managed infrastructure. Either way, the data and the infrastructure stay theirs.

- 9 supported cloud providers plus bring your own VM, you choose region and provider.
- 100+ regions across 20 countries: deploy in Europe or anywhere in the world.
- Managed operations: security, backups, monitoring, updates.

Who it is for

Elestio serves CTOs, heads of engineering and platform teams who want the economics and control of open source without turning it into a full time operations job. It is used across startups, scale ups and regulated organisations that care about where their data lives.

Why it matters now

Two forces are reshaping the market at the same time. AI is making it far cheaper to build and operate software, and users are increasingly tired of rigid, expensive platforms they cannot leave. Elestio's view is that the systems with the heaviest vendor lock-in are the ones most exposed. Managed open source is how teams get modern tooling while keeping the exit door open.
